Crochet pattern for the Fairtrade mark

You will need a 3.5mm hook

Yarn of your choice in black, lime green and sky blue

1. Using black yarn, make a magic ring, chain 1, 6 DC (6)

- 2. Increase in each stitch (12)
- 3. (1dc, inc) x 6 (18)
- 4. (2dc, inc) x 6 (24)
- 5. Switch to sky blue yarn (3dc, inc) x 6 (30)
- 6. (4dc, inc) x 6 (36)
- 7. (5dc, inc) x4. Turn. (28)
- 8. Chain 1 (6dc, inc) x 4. Turn. (32)
- 9. Chain 1 (7dc, inc) x 4. Turn. (36)
- 10. Chain 2, 4tc, 4htc, 4dc. Turn. (13)
- 11. ss, 3dc, 3htc, 3tc. turn (9)

Turn work

Ss, (8dc, inc) x 3, 1htc, 2tc, 3qc. Turn (33)

Switch to black yarn. You will now be working on the central black section of the mark.

12. Working along the edge of the blue, 30dc. You will have to pick up some of the stitches from the ends of the previous rows. Turn. (30)

13. Chain 1, 16dc, 4hdc, 4tc, 4qc. Turn. (30)

14. Chain 2, 4qc, 4tc, 4hdc, 16dc. Turn. (30)

15. Chain 1, 16dc, 3hdc, 4tc, 4qc. Turn. (30)

Switch to lime green yarn.

16. Chain 1, 4dc, 4hdc, 4tc, 6qc, 4tc, 3hdc, 3dc. Turn. (30)

17. ss, ss, 3dc, 3hdc, 3tc, 3qc, 3tc, 3hdc, 3dc. Turn.

18. ss, ss, 2dc, 2hdc, 2tc, 4qc, 2tc, 2hdc, 2dc.

You have now made the Fairtrade mark.

Switch to black yarn.

19. DC in every stitch all around the circle.

20. DC in every stitch all around the circle.

Finish off and weave in ends.
